Product Description: The RedShelf eReader is a browser-based application to render publishers' content, along with tools

to make it easy to read and study.

Evaluation Methods Used: Testing RedShelf eReader involved a combination of manual and functional testing. Level Access (Level) comprehensively tested a selection of pages representative of the RedShelf eReader, among other methodology, the screen reader JAWS 2020 and VoiceOver for OSX, exclusive use of the keyboard, and manual inspection of code and Accessibility API output. Level also functionally tested several user flows of RedShelf eReader, with JAWS 2020 screen reader, VoiceOver screen reader for OSX, ZoomText 2020 screen magnifier, and Dragon® NaturallySpeaking 15.5 speech recognition software.
